

### ***Poster Presentation Instructions***

Poster sessions are a valuable method for authors to present ideas and meet with interested attendees for in-depth technical discussions. Therefore, it is important that you display your results clearly to attract people who have an interest in your work.

Your poster should convey advances in engineering and new engineering opportunities at UGA.

### ***Preparing your Poster Presentation before the Conference***

\* Your poster should cover the KEY POINTS of your work. The ideal poster is designed to (1) attract attention; (2) provide a brief overview of your work; and (3) initiate discussion and questions.

\* The title of your poster should appear at the top in letters approximately 25mm (1") in height. Below the title, put the author(s) name(s) and affiliation(s).

\* Boards will be provided for all poster sessions. They will measure 4 ft (1.22 m) tall x 8 ft (2.44m) wide. Organizers will provide pushpins needed for posting your material on the board.

\* Carefully prepare your poster well in advance of the conference. There will be no time or materials available for last minute preparations at the conference. Bring with you any items needed for preparing or repairing the poster.

\* Use color for highlighting and to make your poster more attractive. Think about what attracts you to posters and other visual displays. Use pictures, diagrams, cartoons, figures, etc., rather than only text wherever possible.

\* The smallest text on your poster should be at least 9mm (3/8") high, and the important points should be in a larger size.

\* Make your poster as self-explanatory as possible. This will save you time to use for discussions and questions.
