#### **The Committee approved the following proposals:**

- ELEE 4040 Communication Electromagnetics (Larry Hornak)
- CSEE 2920, change to 2 credit hours from 4 hours. (extra hours transferred to CSEE 4230 and 4235).
- CSEE 4230 (4 credit hours), split into CSEE 4230 and CSEE 4235 (each 3 credit hours)
- ENGR 6XXX Engineering Properties of Plants (Foutz)
- BIOE 8XXX Systems Physiology Modeling (Hallow)
- ENGR 8250 Computer-Aided Drug Design and Engineering (Xie)
- The committee approved the concept for prerequisite change for ENGR 1120 proposed for ENGR 2120 by the faculty that teach this course. The committee thought it best to retain ENGR 1140 as a pre- or co-requisite for ENGR 2120, and Tom Lawrence will contact the ENGR 2120 instructors about this to get their concurrence.
